Introduction

The Chinese Language Education Center (CLEC) of National Taipei University of Education will organize and hold the Mandarin Summer Camp in 2015. The program will give the youth and children the opportunity to learn Mandarin and experience the Taiwanese culture through all kinds of teaching activities during the camp.

There will be two types of classes this year: **Happy Summer Camp & Elite Summer Camp.**

Happy Summer Camp is a prestigious Mandarin learning program that includes cultural sharing and discussion classes that introduce foreign cultures to kids from all around the world. Through the program, the youth and children will learn about cultural differences as well as see the beauty of Mandarin culture.

Elite Summer Camp is dedicated to individuals who seek to improve and practice Mandarin. Courses will be taught weekly on different topics about Classic Mandarin literature in order to provide students with accessible and practical skills in advanced Mandarin.

Happy Summer Camp

I. Course plan

1. Applicant : Individuals or groups, ranging from the ages of 6-15. Students will be divided according to their Mandarin proficiency; no experience is also acceptable.
2. Location : National Taipei University of Education. 106, No.134, Sec. 2, Heping E. Rd., Taipei (located near MRT Technology Building Station)
3. Class Size : Each class will have a minimum of eight (8) students and a maximum of twelve (12) students.
4. Duration :
 - Session I: 2015/06/22 (Monday) to 2015/07/17 (Friday)
 - Session II: 2015/07/20 (Monday) to 2015/08/14 (Friday)
5. Class Hours : Monday to Friday from 9:00 to 15:50
6. Application Deadline : Until all sessions are full.

III. Price of each session

1. Price per session: US\$1,385 (Tuition: US\$1,350 + Processing Fee: US\$35)
2. Price per session: NT\$39,500 (Tuition: NT\$38,500 + Processing Fee: NT\$ 1,000)

Notice: The price of each session includes tuition, books, materials expense, lunch, dessert, transportation costs, entrance fees, meal expenses during field trips, and insurance. During the summer camp, each participant will be insured NT\$1,000,000 of accident insurance and NT\$100,000 of accidental medical insurance.

Please note that, once paid, the processing fee cannot be refunded.

Elite summer camp

I. Course plan

1. Applicant : Individuals or groups, ranging from the ages of 10-15. Intermediate level in Mandarin listening, speaking, reading and writing is required. Students who are interested in improving practical Mandarin and advanced Mandarin through Classic Mandarin literature. (Those who have participated in CLEC summer camp twice or more will be prioritized.)
2. Location : National Taipei University of Education. 106, No.134, Sec. 2, Heping E. Rd., Taipei (located near MRT Technology Building Station)
3. Class Size : Each class will have a minimum of eight (8) students and a maximum of twelve (12) students.
4. Duration :
 - Session I: 2015/06/22 (Monday) to 2015/07/17 (Friday)
 - Session II: 2015/07/20 (Monday) to 2015/08/14 (Friday)
5. Class Hours : Monday to Friday from 9:00 to 15:50
6. Application Deadline : Elite Summer Camp accepts only one class each session of students who are deemed most suitable by experienced CLEC Mandarin teachers based on the writing and speaking materials they provide during application.
7. Application process :
 - 1) Those who wish to apply for Elite Summer Camp, please email for application questions (writing & oral test questions)
 - 2) Within 7 days of receiving the papers, please email a photocopy/scan of a handwritten article and an audio file to clec@tea.ntue.edu.tw
The materials sent in will be used to determine the applicant's capability in Mandarin, and ultimately the entrance to Elite Summer Camp
 - 3) After receiving an email from CLEC, please return to CLEC online application system to apply, and ensure full payment is completed within 5 days after application.
8. Notices :
 - 1) The Courses of Elite summer camp will focus on Mandarin culture and language through weekly topics. Course content will be relatively challenging and contains a large amount of reading/writing/speaking/listening practices. Field trip time will be relatively less (once a week) and P.E. class is included every day to ensure students get adequate amount of physical activity. Parents/guardians may take the previously mentioned into consideration before applying for your child.

- 2) To minimize the Mandarin lingual ability in class, applicants will be chosen by experienced CLEC teachers based on the submitted writing/oral material.
 - 3) All the students admitted to Elite Summer Camp are checked by CLEC on their Mandarin ability. If the student fails to adapt to the course or need to drop out for personal reasons, he or she may choose to ask for refund or transfer to Happy Summer Camp. If Happy Summer Camp is full by then, CLEC will only provide the option of refund (based on disclosed CLEC refund policy.) There will be no refund for price differences if one chooses to transfer to Happy Summer Camp.
 - 4) Whether or not the applicant is admitted to Elite Summer Camp, he or she will receive an email to announce the results.

IMPORTANT NOTES:

1. If your payment was made through the transfer of money, please go back to our website. There will be a link provided and you must fill out the payment checklist. You will receive an email within 7-10 workdays after payment confirming your

status.

2. Please do not transfer payment by using an ATM machine and make sure that you include the full name of the student enrolling in our program when paying.
3. Once a student is enrolled in a session, that student will not, under any circumstances, be allowed to switch sessions.
4. Once you have applied for the program, you must pay the fee within five (5) working days or the student will automatically be taken out of the system and must start the application process over.

5. Refund policy:

- a. Ask for refund before opening day, 90% of the fee will be refunded. Processing fee will not be refunded.
- b. Ask for refund within the first 1/3 of camp days, 50% of the fee will be refunded. Processing fee will not be refunded.
- c. All refunds will be paid via bank transfer. Processing time around 10 working days.
